Maurice Ravel (7 March 1875 – 28 December 1937) was a French composer, pianist and conductor. In the 1920s and 1930s Ravel was internationally regarded as France's greatest living composer.

*Boléro* (named from the 18<sup>th</sup> century Spanish dance) became Ravel's most famous composition. It is a piece that is a favorite in the orchestra repertoire. It is a piece that you should know.
