

Music 3-5.2 Naming Names II

Objective: Increase music reading proficiency by practicing naming music notes on the Treble Clef Staff. Use the keyboard help-quide above as needed.

Scoring: 100 points (1 point for each correctly named note).

Note that "stave" and "staff" mean the same thing.

- 3) Read the piece of music below. As you read each note, locate it on the piano keyboard image above, matching it with the identical note on the chart.
- 4) Using the piece of music below, create a video of yourself:
 - State your name and grade.
 - Name each note verbally (A, B, C, D, E, F or G), pointing at each one with your finger as you read it.
 - Send your video via Seesaw or Google Classroom.
- 5) Download the free *Piano* app or any free piano keyboard app on your phone or iPad and explore the keyboard, matching up the notes with the piano keys. We will work toward applying written notes to piano keys in future sessions. Another helpful free app is *Notes-Sight Reading Trainer* by Ryan Newsome.
