

SMT Music Listening Log, Grades 6-8

This assignment is a project that you on which you will work in an ongoing basis during the trimester. Every day, listen to music on YouTube and Spotify. Try to hear at least two new songs or one piece of Classical music. Keep a journal of what you have listened to. This "Listening Log" should be in document form, and you should add to your list every day. It will serve as an ongoing record of what you heard. When you log your listening experience, write details that will serve you in your learning. At minimum, document the composer, the date he or she was born (and died, if applicable), the city or country where he or she was born or where s/he lives, the title of the piece and your own personal thoughts about the music you have heard. At least 10% of the pieces you listen to should be from the Renaissance, Baroque, Classic, Romantic, 20th Century or Post-Modern Classical Music genres. The other 90% of what you choose to listen to can be in any other genre as long as it is appropriate. "Listening Log" will appear as a weekly second assignment in Google Classroom; you will submit your completed log in the last week of the trimester. A template is provided below for your convenience, but you may use any format you choose, as long as the requested information is included. The Listening Log will be worth 10% of your overall grade for the trimester.
